I'm sending you information about the Fine Arts Camps Europe (Czech Music Camp for Youth) that will take place in the new location on the Mountain of Holy Mother near the town Kraliky, Czech Republic from July 3 to July 20, 2019. This is our 23<sup>rd</sup> season. Over 180 students (ages 8 - 19) will participate in this unique event which promotes the idea of international understanding through the universal language of music. In the past we hosted students from the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Germany, France, Great Britain, Denmark, Poland, Hungary, Slovenia, Croatia, Serbia, Romania, Greece, Spain, Cyprus, the Ukraine, Lithuania, Russia, Turkey, Georgia, India, the Philippines, Japan, the United States, Canada, Mexico, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Panama, South Korea, and China. However, we would be very pleased to welcome even more international students. We have launched 2% early moment discount for all international students. This offer is valid for applications accepted by February 28 and full payment till March 10. The deadline for applications is May 15, 2019.

v příloze vám zasíláme informační materiály tábora Fine Arts Camps Europe (Český hudební tábor mládeže), jehož 23. sezóna se poprvé uskuteční v nové lokalitě na Hoře Matky Boží u města Králíky ve východních Čechách od 3.7. do 20.7.2019. Více než 180 dětí a mládeže ve věku 8 – 19 let se zúčastní tohoto setkání, které propaguje myšlenku mezinárodního porozumění prostřednictvím společného jazyka, kterým je hudba.

Během uplynulých 22 ročníků jsme v našem táboře přivítali studenty z ČR, Slovenska, Německa, Francie, Velké Británie, Dánska, Polska, Maďarska, Slovinska, Chorvatska, Srbska, Rumunska, Řecka, Španělska, Kypru, Ukrajiny, Litvy, Ruska, Turecka, Gruzie, Indie, Filipín, Japonska, USA, Kanady, Mexika, Kostariky, Salvadoru, Panamy, Korejské republiky a Číny. I přesto bychom velmi rádi dále rozšiřovali mezinárodní účast. U mezinárodních přihlášek přijatých do 28.2. a platby v plné výši do 10.3. je možné se ucházet o extra slevu 2%. Uzávěrka mezinárodních přihlášek je 15.5.2019.

## CAMP PHILOSOPHY

Fine Arts Camps Europe serve students between the ages of 8 through 19. The purpose of this unique educational project is to give our campers opportunity to play in large ensembles like symphony orchestra, symphonic band or choral ensemble. Making music in a large group motivates students to develop their talent. Other music majors such as piano, harp, recorders, and guitar also focus on an ensemble performance.

As our campers come from different countries, we highly promote the idea of international understanding through the universal language of music.

## CAMP HISTORY

We opened our first music camp in Horní Jelení, Czech Republic in 1997. The idea for this project comes from Michigan, U.S.A., which is the location of large fine arts camps (Interlochen and Blue Lake). Our camp founder, **Fr. Walter Marek (1918 – 2010)** served as a treasurer and a board member of Blue Lake since its beginning in 1966. The director of C.M.C.Y. is Fr. Marek's nephew, **Josef Kušička**, who spent 6 summers at Blue Lake as a camper and a counselor.

Since our beginning in 1997 our program has grown in number and quality. In 2001 we have divided our program into 2 sessions due to high demand. This unique educational project received the moral support of the UNESCO in 2004. Exchange program FACE-IN between our camp and Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp in Michigan, USA started in 2013. Czech Music Camp for Youth is registered as a non-profit corporation in the Czech Republic.



## MAJORS SYMPHONIC ENSEMBLES (STRINGS & WINDS)



Both majors offer great opportunity for students to play in large ensembles. They have positive influence on young people who learn how to work as a team and listen to each other. The Band and Orchestra program is designed to challenge students whatever their level of proficiency may be. Our conducting staff selects the repertoire from various symphonic pieces of different styles, periods and composers. This major consists of daily intensive rehearsals, sectionals and technique classes. However, the minimum recommended experience with the music instrument is 2 - 3 years for wind players and 3 - 4 years for string players.

Our 7-day session is also open for our alumni participants over the age of 18.

*I learned new techniques for breathing that help me improve the quality of my sound. The songs challenged me a little instead of being extremely easy. I got to practice speaking Czech. I made a lot of new friends. (Andrea, U.S.A., 11 yrs., symphonic band / clarinet)*  
*I wasn't reading notes at all but after lessons and support from my conductor in orchestra and by private lessons and support from a counselor, who's playing double bass, I've started to actually read them. Benefits of classical education... (Alex, 17 yrs. Russia, symphonic band / bass)*

## UNIFORMS

Camp uniforms are to be worn by all campers, teachers and staff for all concerts and some other activities as decided by camp management. Some parts of the uniform (Blue Lake polo shirts, sweaters, and sweatshirts) may be rented at the camp (fee 40 CZK). New C.M.C.Y./FACE polo shirts (350 CZK) and sweatshirts (450 CZK) can be purchased at the camp. (1 EUR = approx. 25 CZK, 1 USD = approx. 21 CZK). This uniform is to be worn with navy blue or black pants or skirt and dark socks (students have to bring their own). Our laundry service is provided only for uniform items. Since our camp is situated in the middle of the forest, please bring substantial shoes.

## CAMPUS

**FACE CZ** – our new campus is located in Hotel Poutni dum and monastery on the top of the hill near the town Kraliky, approx. 200 km east of Prague. Students will stay in rooms with 2 – 6 beds. Bathrooms are located on each floor. Meals including breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served in the hotel restaurant, snacks and soft drinks will be served in the monastery.

## REFUND POLICY

**70 % of paid tuition will be refunded** to participants who notify camp of cancellation at least 30 days before the opening day.

**60 % of paid tuition will be refunded** to participants who notify camp of cancellation at least 7 days before the opening day.

No refunds will be made in case the camp is notified of cancellation less than 7 days before the opening day or early withdrawal from the camp is made for any reason.

## ELECTIVES

An hour daily will be reserved for electives. Students can choose choir, drawing, harp, piano, percussion elementary, Czech drama, English conversation, music theory, conducting, individual practice, nature hikes, jazz band, and sports.

## EVENING PROGRAMS

Besides music classes, our goal is to show campers the beauty of music also through evening concerts and recitals. Evening concerts and recitals of staff and student ensembles will be held for the whole camp season. All events will take place on campus.
